

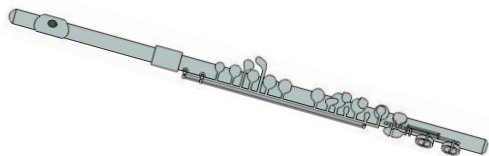
The Evesham Flute Studio's Summer Camps are designed for flutists of all ages and abilities. There are multiple weeks available at the beginner, elementary, intermediate and advanced levels for students who would like to spend more time improving their skills this summer.

The focus of each week will be to solidify all of the skills learned in the previous years of study and prepare for the next school year. Emphasis will be on improving music reading skills, flute technique and ensemble playing.

Students will be introduced to duet, trio and ensemble music. Flute family instruments such as the piccolo, Eb soprano flute, alto flute and bass flute will be available for students to play and hear.

Various genres such as classical, jazz, folk songs, popular melodies, and marches will be included in the repertoire studied.

Each week-long session will conclude with a concert performance during the last 15 minutes of the final class.



### *The Evesham Flute Studio*

was founded in December 2006. The director, Renae Block, has a BS in Music Education from West Chester University, PA, and has been playing and performing for 30 years, and teaching for more than 23 years. She is a member of the National Flute Association, the New Jersey Music Teacher's Association, MENC/NJMEA, and a board member of the Flute Society of Greater Philadelphia and the NJMTA.

Many of her students have achieved placements in regional and state honor bands and have received top honors in other local festivals. Some have also gone on to major in music and have become teachers in school districts up and down the east coast.

## Camp Descriptions

### Elementary Camp (July 26-30, 9:30-10:30):

Students entering 5th or 6th grade who have completed a minimum of one year of flute study in school.

### Intermediate I Camp (Weeks of August 2, 9:15-10:45 and August 9, 11-12:30):

Students entering 6th or 7th grade who have completed 2 years of flute study in school and/or one year of private study.

### Intermediate II Camp (Weeks of August 9, 9:15-10:45 and August 16, 11-12:30):

Students entering 7th or 8th grade who have 3-4 years of flute study in school and/or a minimum of 2 years of private study.

### Advanced I Camp (Week of August 2, 11-1 PM):

For students entering 8th or 9th grade who have 4-5 years of flute study in school and/or a minimum of 3 years of private study.

### Advanced II Camp (Week of July 26, 11-1 PM):

For students entering 10th-12th grade with more than 5 years of flute study in school and/or a minimum of 4 years of private study.

### NEW\*\*Beginner Camp (Weeks of August 16 and 23 at 9:30):

The proper start is crucial to success. Beginner camp offers those students, ages 8 and up who have never studied the flute, the opportunity to learn the very basics of flute playing.

## Schedule of Activities

A typical camp schedule will be broken into small segments, including the following:

Warm-ups ~ Music Theory ~ Flute Technique  
Sight Reading ~Listening/Mini Performances  
Ensemble Time (duets/trios, quartets, etc.)

Some All-South Jersey Band Audition Prep will be included for Intermediate and Advanced Students.

Longer classes will have a snack break built in, and each class will have a concert performance during the last 15 minutes of the final day of the week.

### Other important facts:

Each camp is limited to 8 students—sign up early to assure your child's space in the camps!

Students may sign up for more than one week of camp at the **SAME** level as there will be different materials covered at each camp.

Upon completion of each camp, students may move ahead to the next level at the discretion of the instructor providing there is space available.

## Camp Fees

Fees are to be paid in full at the time of registration to assure your child's placement in the camps and so that materials can be ordered ahead of time.

Walk-in registrations will only be accepted if there is sufficient space in the class - please call ahead for availability.
